



## **An Introduction to Medicaid Waivers**

## What are Medicaid Waivers?

- Medicaid Waivers allow Medicaid to fund supports and services for children and adults with disabilities in their family homes or communities instead of institutions.
- Medicaid Waivers allow an individual to use traditional Medicaid services AND the additional services available
  under a waiver.

### What Medicaid Waivers are available in Indiana?

## **Developmental Disabilities Waivers**

- 1. Family Supports Waiver (FS Waiver)
  - Provides home and community-based supports for individuals who have intellectual or other developmental disabilities, including autism.
- 2. Community Integration and Habilitation Waiver (CIH Waiver)
  - Provides home and community-based supports for individuals who have intellectual or other developmental disabilities, including autism.
  - The level of services available is based upon the individual's level of need and living situation.

## **Division of Aging Waivers**

- 1. Aged & Disabled (A&D) Waiver
  - Provides an alternative to nursing facility admission for adults and persons of all ages with a physical disability.
  - The waiver is designed to provide services to supplement informal supports for people who would require care in a nursing facility if waiver or other supports were not available.
  - Waiver services can be used to help people remain in their own homes, as well as assist people living in nursing
    facilities to return to community settings such as their own homes, apartments, assisted living or Adult Family
    Care.
- Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Waiver
  - Provides home and community-based services to individuals who, but for the provision of such services, would require institutional care.
  - Through the use of the TBI, the Indiana Office of Medicaid Policy and Planning and the Indiana Division of Aging seek to increase availability and access to cost-effective traumatic brain injury waiver services to people who have suffered a traumatic brain injury.

## How do you qualify?

- You must meet Indiana's Medicaid disability and financial eligibility requirements.
- Your family income and assets are NOT counted to determine eligibility for children under 18; however, assets or income in the child's name ARE counted. For those older than 18, only the individual's income and assets are counted.
- You must require the type of care that ordinarily would be provided in a Medicaid-funded facility, such as a nursing home, large residential facility or group home.

## Where do you apply?

- Adults and children with intellectual or other developmental disabilities: Obtain the number for your local Bureau of Developmental Disabilities Services (BDDS) office by calling **800-545-7763**.
- Adults and children with medical needs requiring skilled nursing care/TBI: Obtain the number for your local Area Agency on Aging by calling 800-986-3505.


