Jesters

Founded in 1979, the University of Saint Francis Jesters provides multi-disciplinary performing arts opportunities to people with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD), ages 8-senior citizens. The Jesters program features a summer exploration, a core academic year program with an original culminating performance and guest artist residencies. In 2017, the Jesters presented artists from Second City Theatre Chicago who taught workshops on improvisational skills to people with I/DD. During 2018, the Jesters has launched a new integrated improv group comprised of people with and without disabilities. This year's lecture-demonstration will feature improv games presented by people with I/DD who are part of this new performing group.

Dazzlers Cheerleading Squad

The Whitley County Dazzlers Cheerleading Squad is in their 12th season with nearly 30 team members. This year the team performed in Orlando and spent a day at Disney enjoying each other. It's fun and friendship with a little exercise thrown in for a great show of spirit.

Joyful Songsters

Joyful Songsters is a community choir open to all teens and adults with no audition required. The program is designed to provide an integrated choral experience for individuals with disabilities, senior citizens, and other teens and adults living in Huntington County. Choir members promote a sense of community involvement within their group and throughout the community while participating in high quality music learning and performance. They are currently accepting new singers with or without disabilities. Participation is free.

Power Soccer

Power Soccer is played in power wheelchairs and is one of the most popular adaptive sports in the world. Even those with very limited physical abilities can participate and find great success. The game is played in a gymnasium on a regulation basketball court. Two teams of four players attack, defend, and spin-kick a 13-inch soccer ball.

Turnstone has offered power soccer since 2006.

Athletes as young as 5 years old can participate in power soccer. Athletes' disabilities include quadriplegia, multiple sclerosis, muscular dystrophy, cerebral palsy, and others.

Turnstone offers power soccer competitively and recreationally. Competitive power soccer practices once per week at Turnstone and travels for competitions. Competitions are on weekends at home or travel to games throughout the Midwest. The power soccer season runs from September through June and culminates in a national tournament. Recreational power soccer practices and plays at Turnstone learning the fundamentals of power soccer.

Boccia

In boccia, a set of balls is thrown or rolled onto a court by opposing players, getting as close as possible to a target ball. Players can strategically knock opponents' balls away from the target ball. In adaptive boccia, a ramp can be used to propel the ball, and someone can be used to assist with lining up to ramp during games.



Participants should be at least 12 years old and have the ability to either propel a boccia ball with their hand or foot or utilize a ramp to aim and propel the ball onto the court.

Competitive boccia is open to persons described as quadriplegic with cerebral palsy, traumatic brain injury, stroke survivors, OR persons who have conditions of a non-cerebral origin that affect all four limbs (such as high spinal cord injury, muscular dystrophy, arthrogryposis, MS, or ALS). For recreational purposes, Turnstone allows individuals with other physical disabilities to qualify for this program.

While participating at Turnstone, boccia participants can expect to learn the history and rules of the game, learn the skills and techniques needed to play boccia, enjoy opportunities to play recreationally or

competitively, have opportunities to network with other people with physical disabilities, and engage in a fun and challenging sport.

Boccia is a Paralympic sport in which is trying to grow and prepare for the 2028 Los Angeles Games.




