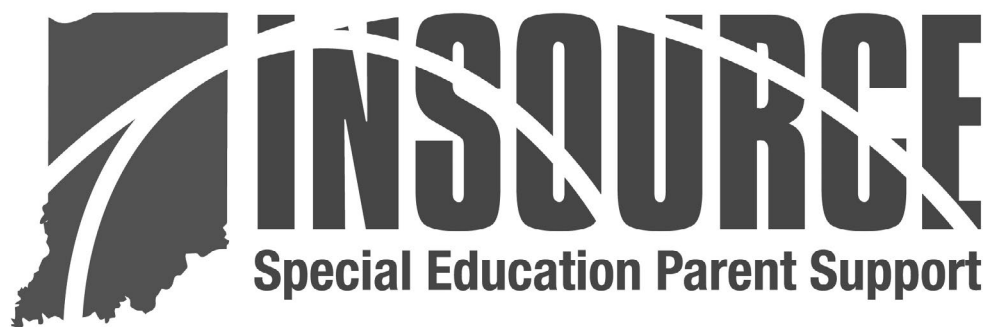

Bring It Push It Own It

Bring It Push It Own It is a local nonprofit providing programs for girls, teens, athletes, and individuals with disabilities. Bring It Mission: To improve mental health by increasing resiliency, confidence and empathy to build strong healthy communities while connecting the brain and heart through movement, mentoring and team-building. Tisha Strasser is the CEO and built this nonprofit from the ground up. Bring It cultivates a safe space for participants to find their inner strength by proving that they can accomplish anything they set out to do. In turn, participants learn to love themselves from the inside out. The "Bring It Method" uses intentional messaging, movement, music, mindfulness and workshops to connect participants to their most authentic joyful life.

Taking Her Voice Back is a Ted-Talk style speaking event that was co-created by Halie Brown and Samara Pfeiffer with the support of Tisha Strasser, CEO of Bring It Push It Own It in 2021. Halie and Samara went through a program of Bring It Push It Own It and discovered their own passions for disability advocacy. Tisha created a platform for them to turn their passion into action. Taking Her Voice Back was

created so other women with disabilities can have a platform to share their voice to the community and world that even though they have a disability, they are still their own success story. Disabilities do not take anything away from abilities, they empower them.

Jesters of the University of Saint Francis



Founded in 1979, the University of Saint Francis Jesters provides multi-disciplinary performing arts opportunities to people with intellectual/developmental disabilities (I/DD), ages 8-senior citizens. The Jesters program features a summer exploration, a core academic year program with an original culminating performance and guest artist residencies. In 2017, the Jesters presented artists from Second City Theatre Chicago who taught workshops on improvisational skills to people with I/DD. During 2018, the Jesters has launched a new integrated improv group comprised of people with and without disabilities. This year's lecture-demonstration will feature improv games presented by people with I/DD who are part of this new performing group.

Joyful Songsters

Joyful Songsters is a community choir open to all teens and adults with no audition required. The program is designed to provide an integrated choral experience for individuals with disabilities, senior citizens, and other teens and adults living in Huntington County. Choir members promote a sense of community involvement within their group and throughout the community while participating in high quality music learning and performance. They are currently accepting new singers with or without disabilities. Participation is free.



Chea Clothing Fashion Show

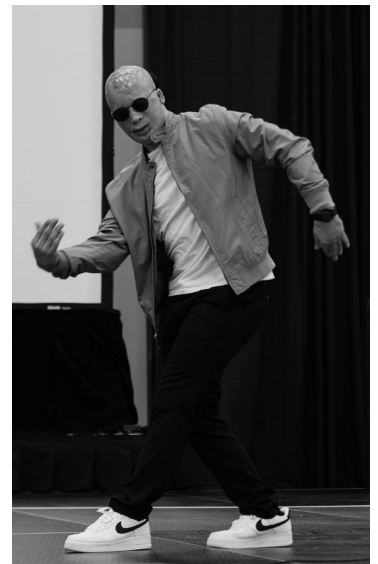

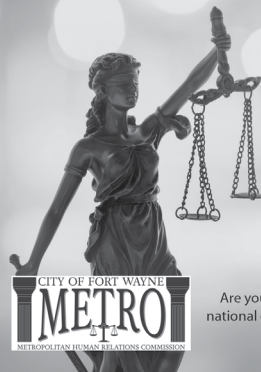
LIBRARY AT HOME

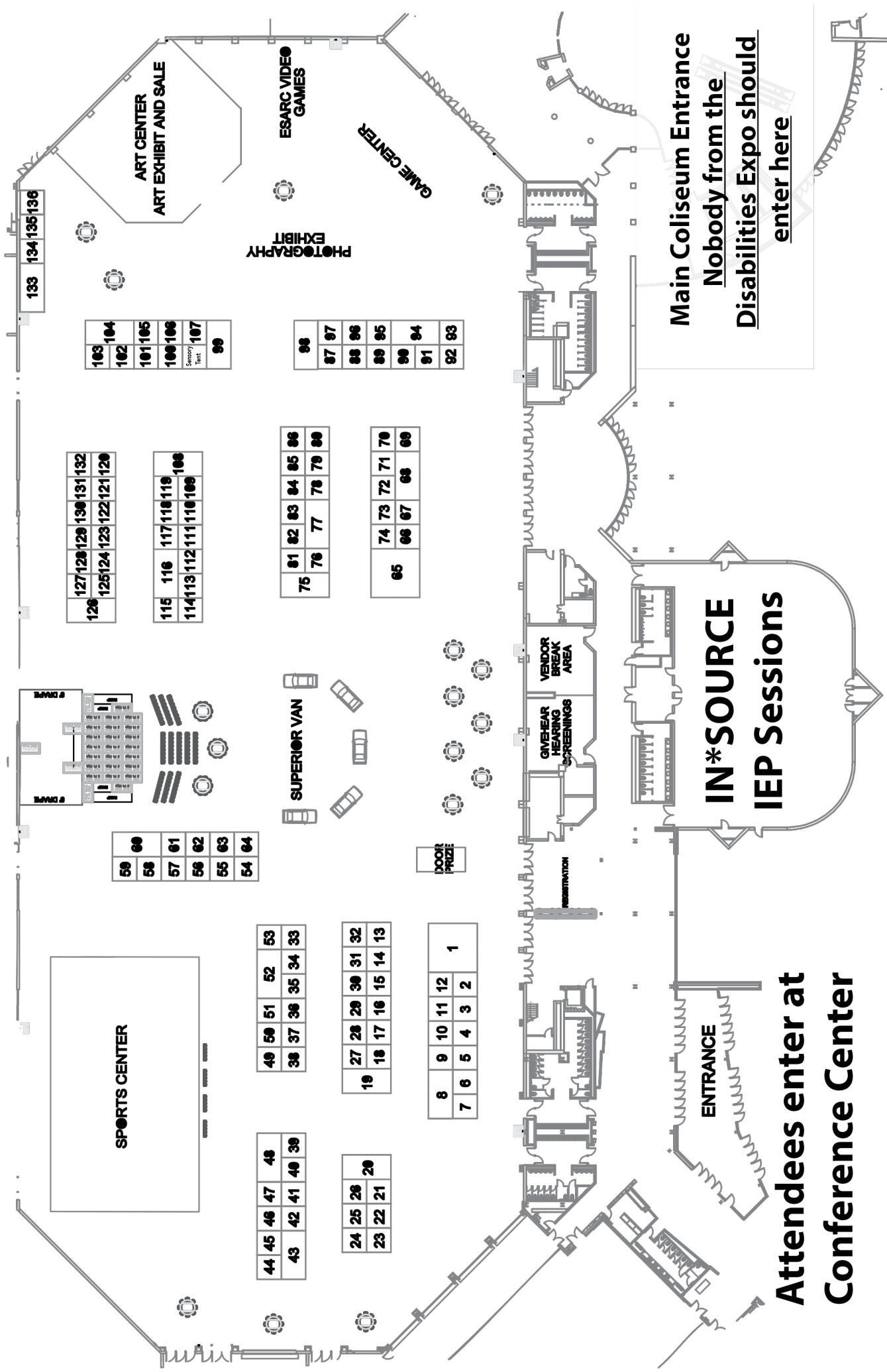

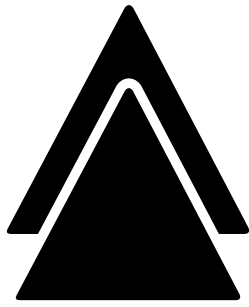
